Town Accepting Applications for Affordable Housing Proposals

The Town of Chapel Hill is accepting applications from non-profit and for-profit housing providers through Friday, Dec. 30, for funding proposals that will advance the Town's affordable housing goals.

The Town will accept applications for these priority project areas: land bank and land acquisition; rental subsidy and development; homeownership development and assistance; and future development planning.

The Town's Housing Advisory Board will evaluate applications and present a funding recommendation to the Town Council for final approval in February 2017. There will be opportunities to submit applications to the AHDR approximately every four months.

Proposed Text Amendment - Innovative-Light Industrial Zoning District (I-2)

Two Public Information Meetings on a proposed new text amendment are scheduled in the First Floor Conference Room at Chapel Hill Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. The meetings will take place on the following dates:

- Tuesday, Jan. 3, 2017 at 6:30 p.m.

Both meetings will provide an introduction and overview of the proposed zoning district. The public information meetings will be identical in presentation, and are scheduled to coincide with Planning Commission meetings, which will begin at 7 p.m. immediately following the Public Information meetings. The Planning Commission will discuss the proposed zoning district at their regularly scheduled meetings on Dec. 20, 2016 and Jan. 3, 2017.
