## Notice of Adoption of Bond Order

### Town of Chapel Hill, North Carolina Notice of Adoption of Bond Order – Public Safety Bonds

The Town Council of the Town of Chapel Hill has adopted the following bond order, providing for the issuance of general obligation public safety bonds. Further information regarding the bonds and the bond order appears at the end of this notice.

BOND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION PUBLIC SAFETY BONDS IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$1,460,000

WHEREAS –

The Town Council of the Town of Chapel Hill has stated its proposal to issue general obligation bonds to pay capital costs of public safety improvements.

The Town has applied to the North Carolina Local Government Commission for its approval of such bonds, and the Commission has accepted the Town's application.

BE IT ORDERED by the Town Council of the Town of Chapel Hill, North Carolina, as follows:

1. There are hereby ordered to be issued general obligation bonds of the Town to pay capital costs of public safety improvements, especially including the purchase of a fire truck and other public safety equipment, together with related financing and other necessary or incidental costs.
2. The maximum aggregate principal amount of the bonds issued for such purpose will be \$1,460,000.
3. Taxes will be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds so issued.
4. A sworn statement of debt prepared by the Town's Finance Officer has been filed with the Town Clerk and is open to public inspection.
5. This Bond Order shall take effect 30 days after its publication following adoption, unless it is petitioned to a vote of the people as provided in Section 159-60 of the North Carolina General Statutes, and in that event the order will take effect when approved by the voters.

The foregoing order was adopted by the Chapel Hill Town Council on December 5, 2016 and is hereby published this 18th day of December, 2016. Any action or proceeding questioning the validity of the order must be begun within 30 days after the date of publication of this notice. The Town's finance officer has filed a statement estimating that the total amount of interest that will be paid on the bonds over the expected term of the bonds, if issued, is \$325,600. The estimate is preliminary, is for general informational purposes only, and may differ from the actual interest paid on the bonds.

## Winter Holiday Service Schedule

Most municipal offices will be closed Dec. 23 and Dec. 26-27.

**RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION:** Yard waste will not be collected Friday, Dec. 23. Trash collection and Thursday yard waste collection will not be affected.

**CURBSIDE RECYCLING:** There will be no change in schedule.

**COMMERCIAL COLLECTION:** There will be no commercial service Friday. Friday's trash will be collected earlier in the week.

**ORANGE COUNTY LANDFILL** will be open Friday and closed Saturday–Monday.

**ORANGE COUNTY SOLID WASTE CONVENIENCE CENTERS** will be open Friday and will close at noon Saturday. Eubanks Road and Walnut Grove Church Road sites will be open Monday.

**CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT:** On Dec. 23, CHT will operate on regular weekday routes and schedules. The Hillsborough Express 420 route will not operate.

There will be no service Sunday, Dec. 25.

On Dec. 24 and Dec. 26, a Saturday service schedule will be in effect (Saturday routes CM, CW, D, FG, JN, and T; no U or NU). EZ Rider will operate 8:15 a.m.–6:52 p.m.

The Hillsborough Express 420 route will not operate Monday, Dec. 26.

Local weekday routes and schedules will be in effect Dec. 27–29 (No A-Limited, CCX, CPX, DX, FCX, HU, JFX, NU). EZ Rider will operate on its regular schedule.

Weekday NU and A-Limited routes will not operate Dec. 19–Jan. 6 and will resume Jan. 9. Weekend U and NU routes will not operate Dec. 17–Jan. 7 and will resume on Jan. 8. EZ Rider's Premium Service will not operate Dec. 25–Jan. 1 and will resume on Jan. 8.

**HOUSING:** Office and Maintenance Division will be closed Dec. 23 and Dec. 26–27. For emergency maintenance services, call 919-968-2855.

**CHAPEL HILL PUBLIC LIBRARY** will be closed Dec. 23–25.

**PARKING SERVICES:** The Parking office will be closed Dec. 23 and Dec. 26–27. On-street parking meters and all off-street metered lots will be free Dec. 23 and Dec. 26–27. Municipal lots, including the Wallace Deck and Rosemary/Columbia lot, will be free Saturday, Dec. 24.

**PARKS AND RECREATION:** The Plant Road administrative office will be closed. Chapel Hill Community Center gym and pool (919-968-2790) will be closed Dec. 24–25. Hargraves Center (919-968-2794) will be closed Dec. 23–Jan. 2. Northside Gym will be open 10 a.m.–4 p.m. Dec. 24, closed Dec. 25, and open 10 a.m.–9 p.m. Dec. 26–30. Homestead Aquatic Center (919-968-2799) will be open 9 a.m.–1 p.m. Dec. 24, closed Dec. 25, and open regular hours Dec. 26–30. The Corner Teen Center will be closed Dec. 23–27 and open regular hours Dec. 28–30.
