Winter Holiday Service Schedule

Most municipal offices will be closed Dec. 23 and Dec. 26–27.

RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION: Yard waste will not be collected Dec. 23. Trash collection and Thursday yard waste collection will not be affected.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING: There will be no change in schedule.

COMMERCIAL COLLECTION: There will be no commercial service Friday. Friday's trash will be collected earlier in the week.

ORANGE COUNTY LANDFILL will be closed Saturday through Monday.

ORANGE COUNTY SOLID WASTE CONVENIENCE CENTERS will be open Friday and will close at noon Saturday. Eubanks Road and Walnut Grove Church Road sites will be open Monday.

CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT: On Friday, Dec. 23, CHT will operate on regular weekday routes and schedules. The Hillsborough Express 420 route will not operate.

There will be no service Sunday, Dec. 25.

On Saturday, Dec. 24, and Monday, Dec. 26, a Saturday service schedule will be in effect (Saturday routes CM, CW, D, FG, JN, and T; no U or NU service). EZ Rider will operate from 8:15 a.m. to 6:52 p.m.

The Hillsborough Express 420 route will not operate Monday, Dec. 26.

Local weekday routes and schedules will be in effect Dec. 27–29: A, CL, CM, CW, D, F, G, HS, J, N, NS, RU, S, T, U and V Routes (No A-Limited, CCX, CPX, DX, FCX, HU, JFX, NU) and the Hillsborough Express 420 Route. EZ Rider will operate on its regular schedule.

Weekday NU and A-Limited routes will not operate Dec. 19–Jan. 6.

Weekend U and NU routes will not operate Dec. 17–Jan. 7.

EZ Rider's Premium Service will not operate Dec. 25–Jan. 1.

Tree collection

Town crews will pick up Christmas trees and wreaths for mulching on the regular yard waste collection schedule. Yard waste is collected on Thursdays from single-family residences on a Monday trash collection schedule and on Fridays from those with Tuesday trash collection.

Remove all decorations, tinsel and wire before leaving trees and wreaths at the curbside along with other yard waste. Residents of apartment complexes should place trees in designated areas as directed by property managers.
