Concept Plan Review: Trinitas, Multi-Family Development

A Concept Plan has been submitted to the Town by Trinitas Ventures to redevelop an apartment complex at 602 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. (known as Central Park Apartments). The submitted plan proposes demolition of three 2-story apartment buildings and construction of four 7-story buildings with 319 dwelling units and parking for 150 vehicles. The 9.1-acre site is identified as Orange County Parcel Identifier Number 9788-49-1242, Project # 11-0268.
