LED Light Test in Parking Deck

The Town of Chapel Hill is seeking input on new LED light fixtures in the Wallace Parking Deck at 150 E. Rosemary St. The LED light test is the first step in a project to install more efficient lighting systems in six Town facilities.

Ceiling-mounted LED fixtures from three manufacturers have been installed in Level 2 of the Wallace Deck. Wall-mounted LED units from two manufacturers have been installed near the elevator access area in Level 3 of the Wallace Deck. Funding for the six-facility project, estimated at about \$100,000, is provided by the U.S. Department of Energy through the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant program that is supported by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.
