St. Paul Village Rezoning Hearings

St. Paul Village Zoning Atlas Amendment

A request has been submitted by the St. Paul AME Church to rezone a development site at 1604 Purefoy Drive at the intersection of Rogers Road. The proposed Zoning Atlas Amendment requires joint approval by the Chapel Hill Town Council and the Orange County Board of Commissioners. A Joint Planning Public Hearing has been scheduled at 7 p.m. Thursday, March 29, at the Southern Human Services Center, 2501 Homestead Road, Chapel Hill.

May 21

Special Use Permit Application

The St. Paul Village rezoning application is accompanied by a Special Use Permit application that proposes a worship campus with a sanctuary, 87 dwelling units and other buildings, 343 parking spaces and 181,186 s.f. of floor area. A public hearing has been scheduled at 7 p.m. Monday, May 21, in the Town Council Chamber in Chapel Hill Town Hall for consideration of the Special Use Permit application by the Chapel Hill Town Council.

Survey Crews at Carolina North Site

Survey crews will be working at the Carolina North site for the next six to eight weeks.

UNC-Chapel Hill has set aside three large areas of ecologically valuable land for conservation on the Carolina North site. To determine the legal boundaries of the areas and to mark them, survey crews will be working on the site. The surveyors may need to remove underbrush alongside the conservation areas to establish a clear line of sight. Vegetation removal will be kept to a minimum and will not occur without specific guidance from University staff on site.
