The Chapel Hill Board of Adjustment will meet at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, Aug. 1, in the Council Chamber of Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., to consider an agenda that includes the following item.

### 550 Chase Park Road – Water Variance Request

The Board of Adjustment will consider a Water Variance request to Land Use Management Ordinance regulations regarding 550 Chase Park Road, located south of Dogwood Drive and north of Smith Avenue (PIN 9788-12-7268, Project #12-017).

## Site Plan Review: Goddard School

The Chapel Hill Planning Board will meet at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, Aug. 7, in the Council Chamber of Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., to consider an agenda that includes the following item.

### Goddard School – 1162 Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd.

The Planning Board will consider a Site Plan Review application from Eric Chupp for construction of a child daycare facility at 1162 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. The 1.1-acre site is located on the east side of Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. across from Critz Drive, south of Taylor Street and identified as Orange County PIN 9789-28-8876 (Project # 12-0051). The application proposes a 1-story, 8,068 square foot child daycare facility for 136 children and parking for 32 vehicles. Vehicular access is proposed from Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd.
