## Parking in Northside and Pine Knolls

Do you live, own property, or often visit friends in the Northside or Pine Knolls neighborhoods? If so, these new and existing parking regulations could affect you!

On Sept. 1, 2012, a new regulation will go into effect which states that maximum of four cars will be allowed to park on a lot. Be sure to park only in designated parking areas, not on grass. Also, be aware that only 40 percent of the front-yard in the Northside neighborhood, and 30 percent in the Pine Knolls neighborhood, can be designated for parking.

Violations could result in fines of up to \$100 per day until the violation is corrected.
