## Leaf Collection Begins Oct. 22

The Town will begin its annual leaf collection on Monday, Oct. 22. Leaf collection will continue through late February. Residents may place loose leaves and pine straw that are free of limbs and debris at the curb. Leaf piles should not block roadways, bike lanes, sidewalks, fire hydrants, water meters, mailboxes, storm drains and utility boxes, or interfere with sight distances at intersections. Rake leaves as early in the season as possible.

Residents may request delivery of leaves for gardens or compost piles by calling the Public Works Department at 919-969-5100. Leaves provide important nutrients to the soil. Call 919-968-2788 for information on composting and purchasing composting bins.
