### Notice of Intent to Authorize a Lease of Property Owned by the Town of Chapel Hill to Holmes Day Care Center Inc.

Notice is hereby given in accord with N.C. GS 160A-272 that the Town Council intends, at its regular meeting of December 3, 2012 to authorize the lease of a building containing approximately 3,850 square feet of space at the Town's Hargraves Recreation Center, 216 North Roberson Street, for the operation of a day care center. Said lease will be for a period of ten years beginning on January 1, 2013. Under the proposed lease terms Holmes Day Care Center Inc. would pay \$380 per month.
