Holiday Service Schedule

Most municipal offices will be closed Dec. 24-26.

RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION: There will be no residential service Dec. 24-25. Monday routes will be collected Thursday, Dec. 27. Tuesday routes will be collected on Friday, Dec. 28. Yard waste will not be collected Dec. 27-28.

COMMERCIAL COLLECTION: There will be no commercial service Dec. 25. Tuesday routes will be collected on Wednesday, Dec. 26, and Thursday, Dec. 27.

ORANGE COUNTY LANDFILL: The landfill will close at noon Monday, Dec. 24, and will be closed Tuesday, Dec. 25.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING: There will be no recycling collection Tuesday, Dec. 25. Tuesday routes will be collected on Saturday, Dec. 29.

ORANGE COUNTY SOLID WASTE CONVENIENCE CENTERS will close at noon Monday, Dec. 24 (Eubanks Road and Walnut Grove Church Road sites) and will be closed Dec. 25-26.

CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT: On Dec. 24 and 26, CHT will operate on a Saturday service schedule for CM, CW, D, FG, JN and T routes (no U or NU service) and EZ Rider will operate from 8:15 a.m. to 6:52 p.m. The Hillsborough Express 420 route will not operate Monday, Dec. 24. There will be no service Tuesday, Dec. 25.

HOUSING: Office and Maintenance Division will be closed Dec. 22-26. For emergency maintenance services, call 919-968-2855.

CHAPEL HILL PUBLIC LIBRARY will be closed Dec. 24-26.

PARKING SERVICES: The Parking office will be closed Dec. 24-26. On-street parking meters and all off-street metered lots (West Franklin, West Rosemary, Mallette and 427 West and South Graham Street Parking Lots) will be free Dec. 24-26. The Wallace Deck and Rosemary/Columbia Lot will be open from 5 p.m. to 12 a.m. Saturday, Dec. 22.

PARKS AND RECREATION: The Plant Road administrative office and Chapel Hill Community Center will be closed. For schedules at the Hargraves Center or Northside Gym, call 919-968-2794; for schedules at the Homestead Aquatic Center, call 919-968-2799.

Christmas Tree Mulching

Town crews will pick up Christmas trees and wreaths for mulching on the regular yard waste collection schedule. Yard waste is collected on Thursdays from single-family residences on a Monday trash collection schedule and on Fridays from those with Tuesday trash collection.

Remove all decorations, tinsel and wire before leaving trees and wreaths at the curbside along with other yard waste. Residents of apartment complexes should place trees in designated areas as directed by property managers.

Residents of Chapel Hill who are registered voters and otherwise qualified to hold office are invited to apply to fill a vacant seat on the Town Council resulting from the resignation of former Council Member Penny Rich.

There is no official form for applications. Applications must include the name, residence address, and signature of the applicant. The original application with an original signature must be submitted and received by the Town Clerk by 5 p.m. Monday, Jan. 7, 2013. The Town Clerk's Office is located in the Communications and Public Affairs Department on the second floor of Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Chapel Hill, NC 27514.

Applicants may include information in support of the application if they wish and are encouraged to provide a written statement (500 words or less) outlining the applicant's view of issues facing the Town of Chapel Hill and interest in serving on the Town Council.
