## Apply for Vacant Council Seat

Residents of Chapel Hill who are registered voters and otherwise qualified to hold office are invited to apply to fill a vacant seat on the Town Council resulting from the resignation of former Council Member Penny Rich.

There is no official form for applications. Applications must include the name, residence address, and signature of the applicant. The original application with an original signature must be submitted and received by the Town Clerk by 5 p.m. Monday, Jan. 7, 2013. The Town Clerk's Office is located in the Communications and Public Affairs Department on the second floor of Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Chapel Hill, NC 27514.

Applicants may include information in support of the application if they wish and are encouraged to provide a written statement (500 words or less) outlining the applicant's view of issues facing the Town of Chapel Hill and interest in serving on the Town Council.

**ORANGE COUNTY LANDFILL:** The landfill will be closed.

**CURBSIDE RECYCLING:** There will be no recycling collection. Tuesday routes will be collected on Saturday, Jan. 5.

**ORANGE COUNTY SOLID WASTE CONVENIENCE CENTERS** will be closed Jan. 1-3.

**CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT** will operate on a regular weekday schedule on Monday, Dec. 31. There will be no service Jan. 1.

**HOUSING:** Office and Maintenance Division will be closed. For emergency maintenance services, call 919-968-2855.

**CHAPEL HILL PUBLIC LIBRARY** will be closed.

**PARKING SERVICES:** Parking Services will operate on its normal schedule (7:30 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.) Monday, Dec. 31. The Parking office will be closed Tuesday, Jan. 1. On-street and off-street metered lots (West Franklin, West Rosemary, Mallette and 427 West and South Graham Street) will be free Jan. 1.
