#### Amendments to the Land Use Management Ordinance and the Northside and Pine Knolls Neighborhood Conservation Districts

The Chapel Hill Town Council will hold a public hearing to receive public comment about proposed amendments to the Land Use Management Ordinance, the Northside and Pine Knolls Neighborhood Conservation Districts.

The Planning Board will also review the proposed amendments at 7 p.m. Tuesday, April 2, 2013, in the Council Chamber at Chapel Hill Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Chapel Hill, NC 27514.

The Town Council is tentatively scheduled to consider possible enactment of the amendments on May 29, 2013. This meeting will be held at 7 p.m. in the Council Chamber of Chapel Hill Town Hall.

The last scheduled pick-up window will be 6:42–7:02 p.m. Safe Rides will operate as normal on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. CHT will return to regular service on Sunday, March 31.

**HOUSING:** Office and Maintenance Division will be closed. For emergency maintenance services, call 919-968-2855.

**PARKING SERVICES:** The Parking office will be closed. The Wallace Deck at 150 E. Rosemary St. and the Rosemary/Columbia lot will be open. All other Town-owned lots and on-street parking meters will be free.
