The Board of Adjustment will consider an Appeal of fines associated with a Town final written Notice of Condemnation for Zoning and North Carolina General Statutes Violations for 135 North Street.

Transit Routes Adjusted Due to South Columbia Street Project

Due to the NC Department of Transportation project to widen South Columbia Street between Purefoy Road and Manning Drive and other road construction projects, Chapel Hill Transit (CHT) will implement schedule changes and detours starting May 13.

From May 13 to Aug. 13, traffic on South Columbia Street will be one-way (northbound) from Fordham Boulevard towards Manning Drive. Outbound traffic will be detoured along Manning Drive.

Routes affected include: CCX, CPX, D, J, JFX, NS, PX, V, JN Saturday, RU, and T Saturday. For schedule information, visit www.chtransit.org or tinyurl.com/a3muvuh.
