Concept Plan Review: Calvander-Eubanks Duke Energy Substation, 1615 Eubanks Road

A concept plan has been submitted to the Town by Scott Murray Land Planning, Inc. to construct a Duke Energy power substation. The 13.24-acre site is located at 1615 Eubanks Road adjacent to the Orange County Animal Hospital on the north. Genestu Drive and a railroad line bisect the property. The property is in the Residential-1 zoning district and is outside the Town limits (Orange County Parcel Identification Numbers 9870-77-6296 and 9870-76-4978). 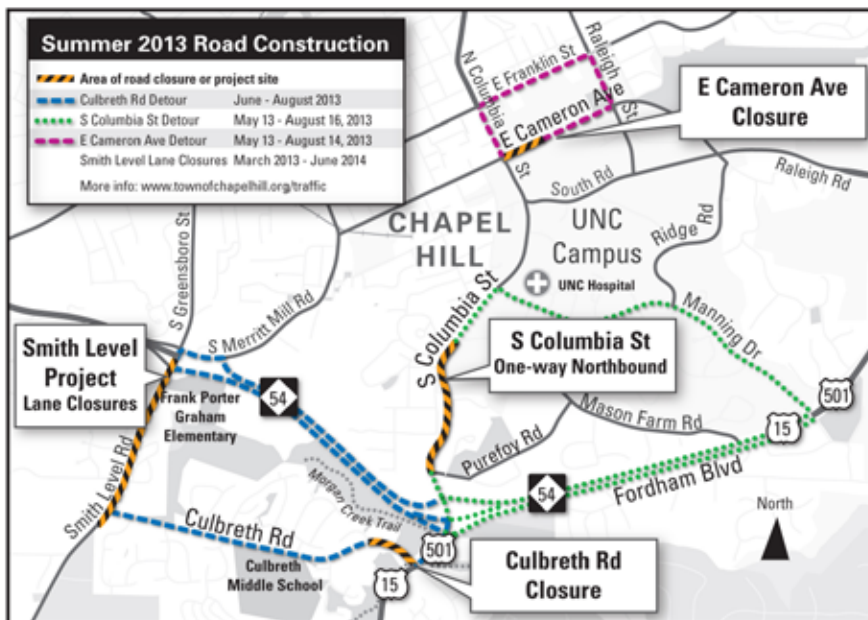

Transit Summer Break Schedule

Chapel Hill Transit is now operating on a summer break schedule. Weekday CM, CW, D, J and NU routes will end earlier in the evening and weekend U and NU routes will not operate. The regular schedule will resume on Aug. 13. Safe Ride routes will not operate during the summer break and will resume on Aug. 22. EZ Rider service will adjust service hours for the summer starting May 11.
