Celebrate the opening of the new Chapel Hill Public Library by learning about the library's 55 year history, from its first location in a Franklin Street residence in the late 1950s to the new 63,800-square foot building in Pritchard Park.

The annual meeting of the Friends of the Chapel Hill Public Library at 2:30 p.m. Sunday, May 19, will be followed by a special presentation on the history of the library from 3 to 5 p.m. A panel of past library directors and staff will present an illustrated program, followed by a guided tour of the Library.

Culbreth Road Public Information Meeting

The Town of Chapel Hill will hold a public information meeting to discuss the impacts of the Morgan Creek Trail Improvement Project, including the upcoming closure of Culbreth Road Closure, at 7 p.m. Thursday, May 23, at Culbreth Middle School, 225 Culbreth Road.

The \$1.458 million project will construct about 1,200 linear feet of trail with two bridges and an underpass of Culbreth Road. Once completed, the combined Fan Branch Morgan Creek Trails will be the longest paved trail system in Orange County and will allow unbroken travel from the Southbridge neighborhood to Southern Community Park.

In order to install the pedestrian tunnel under Culbreth Road, it will be necessary to close the eastern end of Culbreth Road from June 8 to Aug. 25, 2013. Culbreth Road will be completely closed on its east end (near Highway 15-501) to all traffic including vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists. Programs this summer include CPR, Belly Dancing, Shotokan Karate, tennis and swimming.

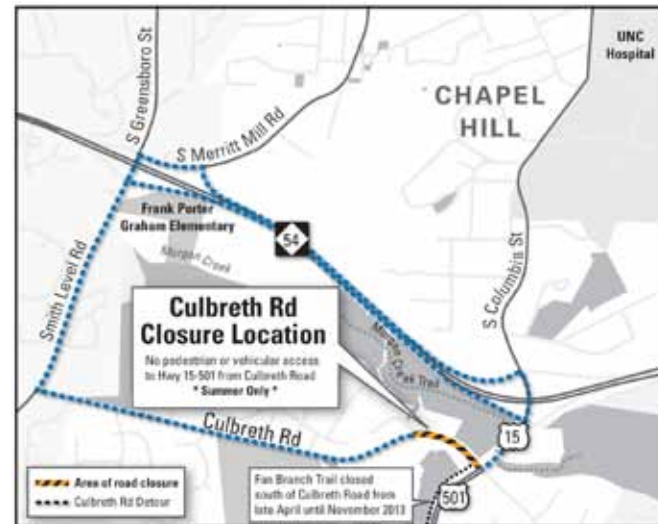
