### Apply for the Obey Creek Compass Committee

The Town of Chapel Hill will accept applications for the Obey Creek Compass Committee through June 10. Members are expected to be announced in June, and a bulk of their work will take place in July and August.



The committee will review information about the proposed development, participate in scheduled events and serve as a conduit to the community for the purpose of providing information, soliciting community response and fostering community participation in the development of a site concept plan. At the end of the process, the committee will provide the Council with a report that identifies key issues, principles, and interests to be considered before in the next potential phase of discussions and negotiations.

Obey Creek is a 124-acre property under consideration for a mixed use development proposed for the area across South 15-501 from Southern Village. It is one of two potential developments using the new development agreement process approved by Council in March 2013.
