Meet at the Glen Lennox Apartment leasing center at 5 Hamilton Road (in the back left portion of the first building on the left when you enter Hamilton Road from Raleigh Road). Park at Glen Lennox shopping center or along Hamilton Road. Experience the property first-hand, and hear from the developer about how they propose to develop the site.

A Public Input Session of the new development agreement process for Glen Lennox will be held from 6:30 to 9 p.m. Wednesday, June 26, in Meeting Room B of the Chapel Hill Public Library, 100 Library Drive. This is an opportunity for members of the community to gather and share existing information, and provide feedback on key topics and interests regarding the project. The Technical Team, experts in a variety of fields charged with facilitating a technical review of the project proposals in light of community interests, will attend the meeting.
