**Subject:** City of Asheboro Transfer Station Site Visit

The Town of Chapel Hill sponsored a site visit to the City of Asheboro Transfer Station located at 630 Transfer Station Place, Asheboro, NC, on Wednesday, September 19, 2012. A tour of the facility was led by Kermit Williamson, City of Asheboro Environmental Services Superintendent, and lasted approximately an hour, beginning around 10:10 a.m. Mr. Williamson provided an overview of the facility's operations and answered individual questions.

It was discussed that the City of Asheboro and the Town of Chapel Hill are similar in size and waste generation. In fiscal year 2010-2011, the City of Asheboro collected 14,454 tons and the Town of Chapel Hill collected 14,699 tons. The City of Asheboro's transfer station is operated by the City and only accepts waste from the City's collection vehicles. Waste from the facility is transferred to Uwharrie Environmental Regional Landfill in Montgomery County, NC.
