New Fee at Park and Ride Lots

Starting Thursday, Aug. 15, new fees will be in effect at the following Chapel Hill Transit park and ride lots: Carrboro Plaza, Eubanks, Southern Village and Jones Ferry. The fees are \$2 per day, \$21 per month, or \$250 per year. Monthly and annual permits for park and ride lots managed by CHT are available for purchase online at www.townofchapelhill.org/prlots. Customers will also be able to utilize daily parking by paying a \$2 fee at pay-stations located at each lot.

UNC-Chapel Hill will also implement fees for their park and ride permits, effective Aug. 15. UNC park and ride permits will be honored in Town lots.
