Use Care at Crosswalks

Whether you are walking or driving, use caution at pedestrian refuge islands and crosswalks along Martin Luther King Jr.

Boulevard and East Franklin Street. The pedestrian islands and crosswalks are located mainly at mid-block crossing locations with bus stops on both sides.

Pedestrians should not feel overly secure when using a marked crosswalk to the degree that they may place themselves in a hazardous position. Unfortunately, some drivers fail to obey the North Carolina law that says they must yield to pedestrians in a crosswalk. For this reason, pedestrians should remain alert while crossing.

Beginning in October 2013, the Chapel Hill Police Department will conduct enforcement operations at crosswalks throughout town. Officers will be citing motorists for failing to yield to pedestrians within the crosswalk and citing pedestrians for crossing against the signals or crossing outside the crosswalk. Transit Service Adjustments

Chapel Hill Transit will implement schedule adjustments starting Monday, Aug. 19. CCX, CPX, J, JFX, NS, PX, RU, V and Saturday JN routes will return to regular routes and schedules. D Route will continue on detour until Culbreth Road is reopened and will not serve Culbreth Road, Smith Level Road or the NC 54 Bypass (Kingswood Apartments). The Culbreth Road Shuttle will continue to operate for the duration of the detour. Routes with schedule changes include CM, CW, D, J, NU, F, NS, Saturday CM, Saturday CW and Saturday JN.

Safe Rides will operate on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings when UNC is in session starting Thursday, Aug. 22.

EZ Rider will operate from 5:30 a.m. to 12 a.m. Monday through Friday, from 8:15 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. on Saturdays and from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. on Sundays.
