Fee Waivers Extended

The Town of Chapel Hill has extended the period of time that it is waiving fees for pickup of flood related debris and for permits related to correcting flood damaged properties until Sept. 4.

Fees waived include solid waste bulky items (appliances, electronics and furniture); inspection division fees (electrical, plumbing, mechanical, demolition, temporary power, change of contractor, temporary certificate of occupancy, insulation, decks and accessory structures); Administrative Zoning Compliance Permits; Single Family/2-Family Zoning Compliance Permits: Regular and Express; and building permits for repairs and renovations associated with flood damage.
