## Holiday Service Schedule

Most municipal offices will be closed Thursday and Friday, Nov. 28-29.

**TOWN HALL AND REVENUE COLLECTION:** All offices will be closed on Thursday and Friday, in observance of Thanksgiving.

**TRASH COLLECTION:** There will be no yard waste collection Thursday or Friday.

**RECYCLING:** There will be no curbside collection on Thursday. Thursday routes will be collected Saturday. There will be no change in schedule on Friday.

**LANDFILL** will be closed Thursday and will re-open at 7 a.m. Friday. (Orange County)

**SOLID WASTE CONVENIENCE CENTERS** will be closed Thursday, and will re-open at 7 a.m. Friday. (Orange County)

**LIBRARY:** The library will be closed Thursday and Friday. Saturday hours will be 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. The Saturday phone number to call is 919-968-2745.

**CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT** will not operate on Thursday. Administrative Offices will be closed Thursday and Friday.

A Saturday service schedule will be in effect on Friday and Saturday. The following Saturday routes will run: CM, CW, D, FG, JN and T (No U or NU routes and EZ Rider will operate from 8:15 a.m.–6:52 p.m.).

On Sunday, the U and NU will run on regular schedules.

Safe Rides will not operate the week of Thanksgiving and will resume on Thursday, Dec. 5.

**PARKING SERVICES:** The parking office will be closed Thursday and Friday. On-street parking will be free Thursday and Friday. Municipal parking lots are free on Thursday. The Wallace Deck and Lot 2 will operate on the regular schedule on Friday.

Chapel Hill Community Center will be closed Thursday and Friday and open 8:30 a.m.–8 p.m. Saturday and 11:30 a.m.–10 p.m. Sunday.

**HOUSING:** Office and Maintenance Division will be closed Thursday and Friday. For emergency maintenance services, call 919-968-2855.

**EMAIL AND PHONES:** The Town of Chapel Hill will take advantage of slower service demands during Thanksgiving weekend to conduct a network improvement project that will cause a temporary disruption of email and telephone communications – with the exception of 911, the available anytime phone number for all emergencies.
