Mayor and Council to Take Oaths of Office

The Town Council will gather for the post-election swearing in of the Mayor and Council Members at an organizational meeting set for 7 p.m. Monday, Dec. 2, at Orange County Southern Human Services Center, 2501 Homestead Road.

The oath of office will be administered to Mayor Mark Kleinschmidt, Council Member-Elect George Cianciolo, Council Member Sally Greene, Mayor Pro tem Ed Harrison and Council Member-Elect Maria Palmer. In addition, the Council will consider a resolution of appreciation to Council Member Laurin Easthom and Council Member Gene Pease for their service to the Town. The business of the meeting also will include the seating of the new Council, election of the mayor pro tempore, and appointment of Council liaisons and representatives.

It is also cablecast live on Time Warner Cable Channel 180 or 97.6, both Orange County public access channels. It will be rebroadcast on Chapel Hill Gov-TV 18 throughout the week.
