The Chapel Hill Fire Department urges residents to “Keep the Wreath Green” this holiday season by keeping their homes safe from fire. Fire Station #1 at 403 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. displays a wreath filled with green lights. For each residential fire in Chapel Hill through New Year’s Day, the department will replace a green bulb with a red one.



The risk of fire is greater during the holiday season with increased use of candles, fireplaces, decorative lighting and live Christmas trees. Keep your home safe from fire by not leaving cooking or open flames unattended and using UL-approved lights and extension cords.
