Zoning-Building Permits Made Easier

The Town of Chapel Hill will begin using a new, simplified application for Residential Zoning-Building permits on Jan. 1, 2014. On the same date, the Town will begin using a new Sub Permit application. The change will affect Single Family and Two Family residential projects in addition to all electrical, mechanical, and plumbing work.

After Jan. 1, 2014, all Residential Zoning – Building Permit Applications and Sub Permit Applications must be submitted on the new form. Old application forms will not be accepted.

The new process responds to homeowner and contractor requests for a simplified application and a streamlined application process. The changes support a Council goal to improve the Town's development review process. Administrative changes are being made to reduce review times.

There will be no change in schedule Dec. 24 and Dec. 26. There will be no recycling collection on Dec. 25. Wednesday routes will be collected on Saturday, Dec. 28.

ORANGE COUNTY SOLID WASTE CONVENIENCE CENTERS

will close at noon Tuesday, Dec. 24 and will be closed Dec. 25. Eubanks Road and Walnut Grove Church Road sites will be open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Dec. 26.

CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT: There will be no service Wednesday, Dec. 25. A Saturday service schedule (no U or NU service) will be in effect Dec. 24 and Dec. 26 for the following routes: CM, CW, D, FG, JN and T. EZ Rider will operate from 8:15 a.m. to 6:52 p.m. The Hillsborough Express 420 route will not operate on Dec. 24.

HOUSING: Office and Maintenance Division will be closed Dec. 22–26. For emergency maintenance services, call 919-968-2855.

CHAPEL HILL PUBLIC LIBRARY will be closed Dec. 24–26.

PARKING SERVICES: The Parking office will be closed Dec. 24–26 and all lots and meters will be free. Parking is free on Saturday, Dec. 28, at meters all day and at municipal lots until 5 p.m.

PARKS AND RECREATION: The Plant Road administrative office and Chapel Hill Community Center will be closed. For schedules at the Hargraves Center or Northside Gym, call 919-968-2794. The Aquatic Center will close at 12:30 p.m. Dec. 24 and will be closed Dec. 25.
