Newbery Award-Winning Author Kwame Alexander

Newbery Medalist Kwame Alexander will read from and sign copies of his new book *The Playbook* at 3 p.m. Sunday, March 19, in Meeting Room B of the Chapel Hill Public Library, 100 Library Drive.

Alexander is a poet, educator, and New York Times bestselling author of 21 books - including *Booked* and *The Crossover*, which received the 2015 John Newbery Medal and the Coretta Scott King Author Award Honor.
