#### Voluntary Annexation Petition: Merin Road Community

The Town of Chapel Hill received a voluntary annexation petition for 24.763 acres of land owned by Capkov Ventures, Inc. and Dayspring Investments, Inc. for the Merin Road Community. The parcel is located at 8201 Merin Road, near the intersection at Homestead Road. In accordance with G.S. 160A-31, the Council will hold a public hearing to receive citizen comment on the petition. The plans also document how the proposed activities will address the Town and County's affordable housing and community development priorities and objectives. All comments received will be incorporated into the final document that will be submitted to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) by May 15, 2017.

## Food Trucks Are Coming for the Rodeo on Rosemary!

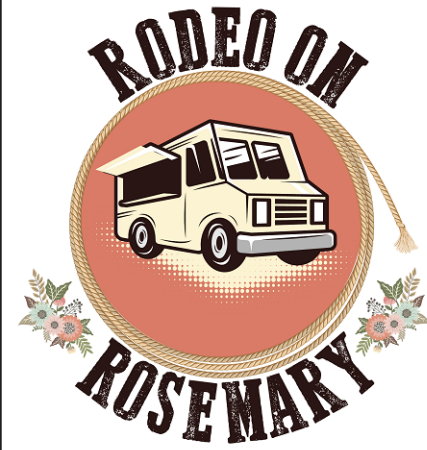
The Rodeo on Rosemary will take place from noon to 5 p.m. Sunday, March 26 on Rosemary Street between Henderson and North Columbia streets
