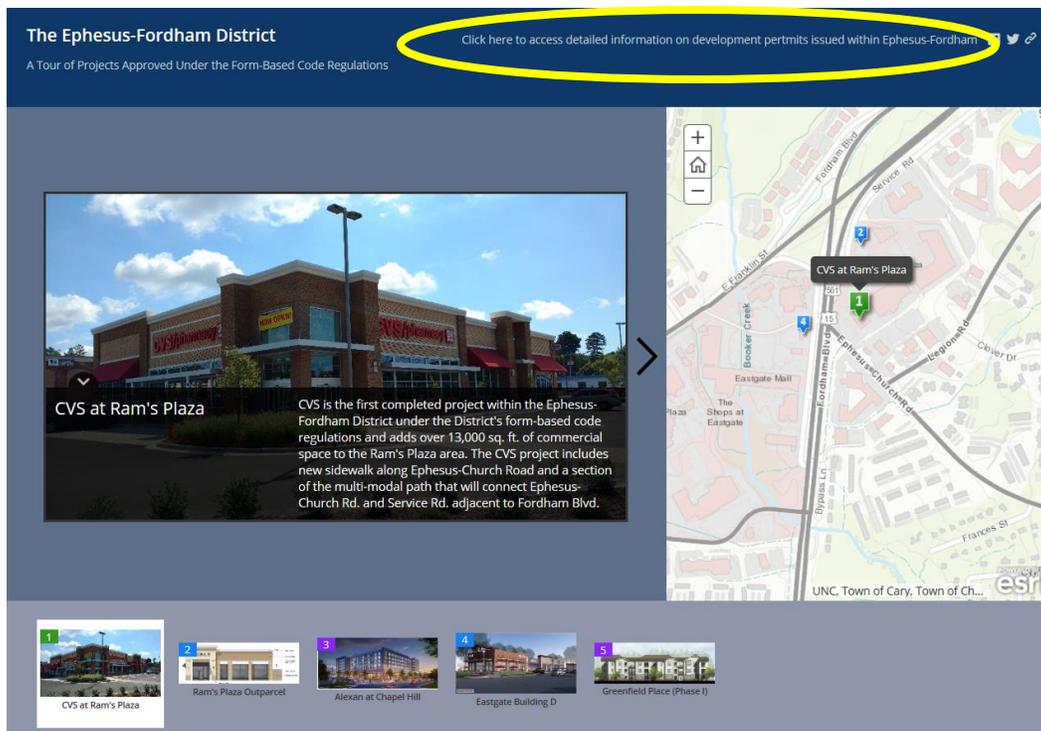


Ephesus/Fordham Development Story Map Guide

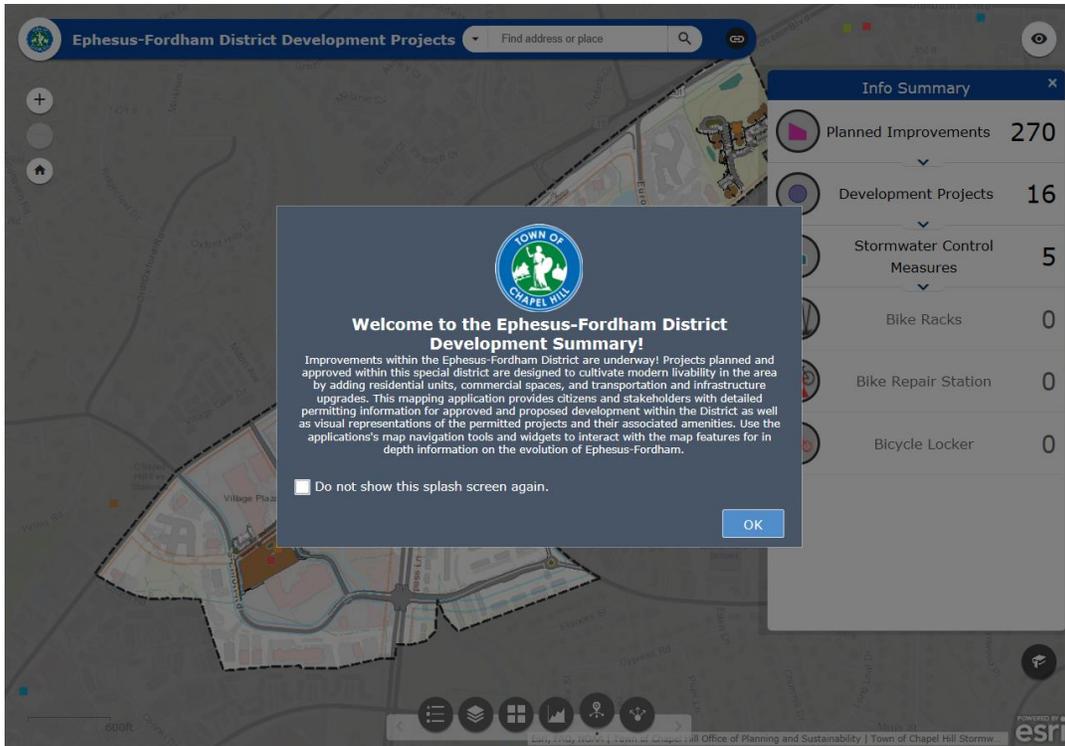

1. Click or type in the following link: <http://arcg.is/2IP3kNg>¹ (works best in Internet Explorer, Mozilla and Chrome browsers).
2. Click on each of the images at the bottom of the page to pull up some basic information about each of the approved form district permits.

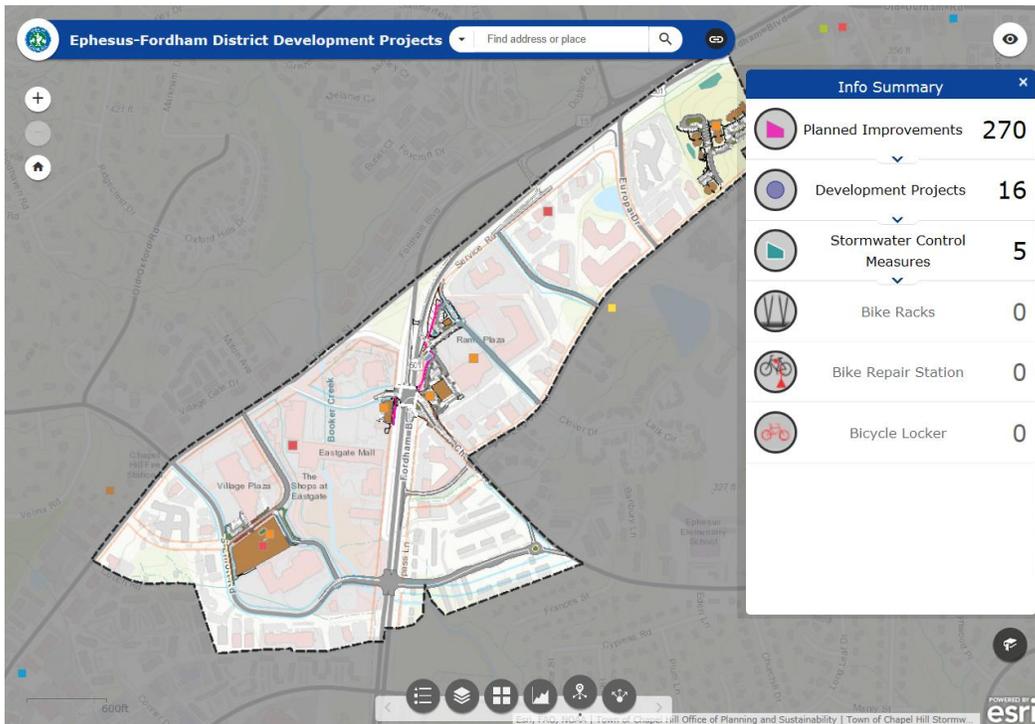


3. Click on the link circled above (in yellow) to locate additional project information.
4. On the next screen (image shown below), click "OK".

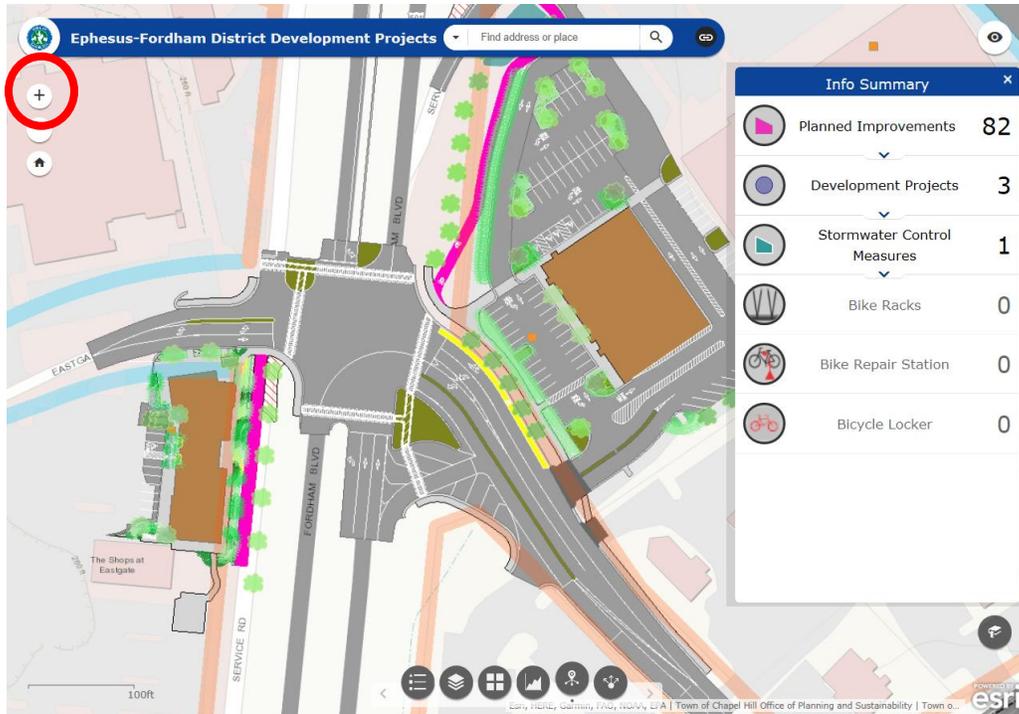

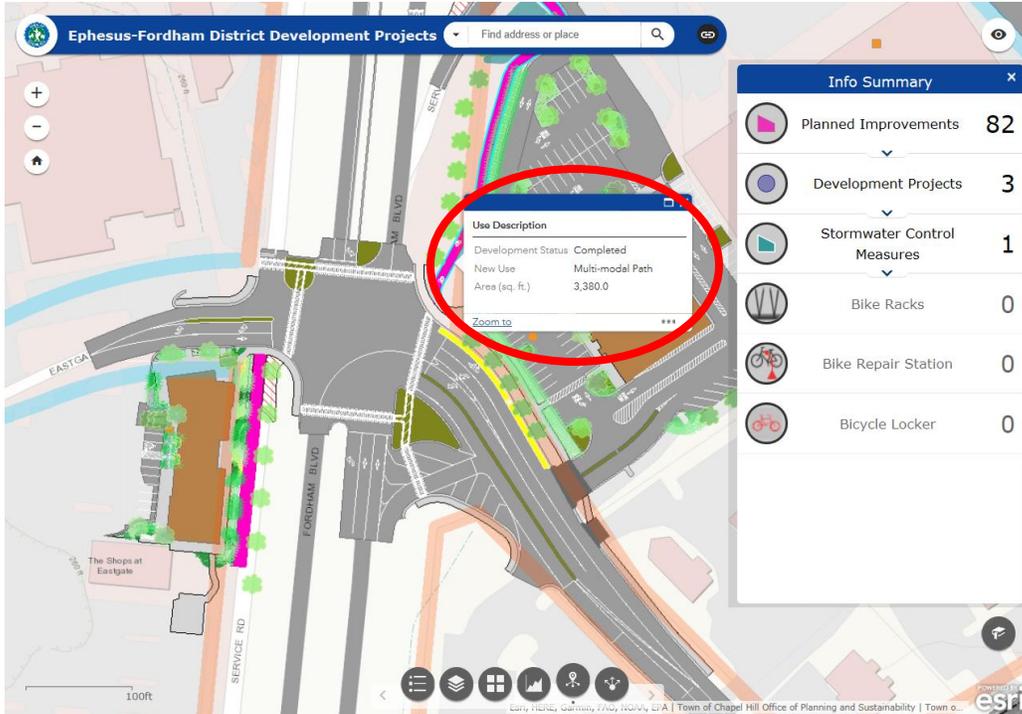
- The base map (shown below) depicts the planned improvements for each of the projects with an approved form district permit. Note: Roadway improvements and planned streets on the Regulating Plan are also shown.



- Use the mouse and the zoom feature in the upper left corner of the screen (circled in red below) to take a closer look at the different development project features and public infrastructure (e.g., Eastgate Building D, intersection improvements at Ephesus Church Road/Fordham Blvd and CVS shown below).



- Click on individual drawn features for additional information. Each clickable feature will be highlighted in light blue (e.g., the new multi-modal path in front of CVS shown below, circled in red).



- Staff from the Planning divisions of GIS & Analytics and Community Sustainability are continuing to add new features as projects are approved and changes are made in the District. This version of the Story Map is designed to highlight and begin aggregating those changes as they take place.
