The Chapel Hill Town Council will meet at 7 p.m. Monday, May 15, in the Council Chamber of Chapel Hill Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., to consider an agenda that includes the following:

Public Hearing on Town Budget

The Council invites residents to express their views on:

- Town services and projects for the budget for July 1, 2017, through June, 30, 2018;
- Capital Improvement needs for 2018–2033;
- How to use the 2017–2018 federal and state transit grants for capital projects, operating costs and transportation planning;
- The Downtown Service District services in the year beginning on July 1, 2017

The Town Manager's Recommended 2017–18 budget is on file with the Town Clerk and will be available for review in the Communications and Public Affairs Department in Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., and at the reference desk in the Chapel Hill Public Library, 100 Library Drive.

Shuttles to UNC Commencement

Chapel Hill Transit will provide shuttle service from 6:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Sunday, May 14, for the UNC-Chapel Hill commencement ceremony at Kenan Stadium. Shuttles will operate from park and ride lots at the Friday Center, 200 Friday Drive, to Kenan Stadium Gate 2 on Stadium Drive. Buses will run every 10 to 15 minutes, providing continuous and fully accessible service. Shuttles and parking at the Friday Center will be free. Riders are encouraged to arrive at least one hour prior to the start of the 9 a.m. ceremony to allow for possible traffic delays.
