Notice of Special Meeting on July 10, 2017 And Notice of Public Hearing: Proposed Ordinance to Allow Sale of Alcoholic Beverages for On-Premises Consumption on Sundays Beginning at 10 a.m.

The Chapel Hill Town Council will hold a special meeting and public hearing at 6 p.m. July 10, 2017 in the Town Council Chambers, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Chapel Hill, NC, to consider an ordinance to allow the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption on Sundays from 10 a.m. to noon, pursuant to the licensed premises' permits issued under N.C. General Statute Section 18B-1001.

The Council intends to consider enactment of this ordinance to implement authorization granted by N.C. General Statute Section 160A-205.3, as enacted by Session Law 2017-87, Section 4.(c).

The proposed ordinance would allow the sale of alcoholic beverages in those premises permitted by the State for on-premises sale and consumption only.

Consideration of an ordinance that would allow for the sale by establishments with permits for sale of alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption is being deferred until the Council reconvenes in September. Further public notice and hearing will be provided before any ordinance is considered.

Public Comment on CDBG Annual Update

The 2017-2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Annual Update to the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan has been amended, following notification from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) of the Town of Chapel Hill's final grant allocation amount. The document reflects a 2 percent decrease in allocation, from the original budget, with no change to the approved program plan activities.

The public is invited to review and comment on the document, which will be made available during normal business hours of operation for a period of fourteen (14) days beginning Monday, July 17, 2017, at the following locations:
