Transit Winter Break Schedule

Chapel Hill Transit will make service schedule adjustments due to the UNC-Chapel Hill winter break schedule.

- The weekday A-Limited morning trips (7:14–9:44 a.m.) will not operate Dec. 18–Jan. 5, and will resume on Monday, Jan. 8, 2018.
- The weekday NU route will not operate Dec. 18–Jan. 5, and will resume on Monday, Jan. 8, 2018.
- The weekend U and NU routes will not operate beginning Saturday, Dec. 16, 2017, and will resume on Sunday, Jan. 7, 2018.
- Safe Ride routes will not operate beginning Thursday, Dec. 14, and will resume on Thursday, Jan. 11.

House Check Service

Leaving town for the holidays? The Chapel Hill Police Department can keep an eye on your property while you're away. Officers will perform a house check on request. Complete a request form at <http://bit.ly/2AsZwNP>. This service is available all year, not just during the holiday season.

Other ways to keep your home secure:

- Store valuables out of sight;
- Lock all doors and windows (even if they're on the second floor);
- Set lights around the house on timers; and
- Break down identifiable boxes before placing them on the street in front of your home for pickup.
