### January 17 – Flemington Road Public Hearing

On Jan. 17, 2018, the Chapel Hill Town Council will hold a public hearing at 7 p.m. in the Council Chamber of Chapel Hill Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., to consider a request to permanently close portions of the Flemington Road public right-of-way between Maxwell and Brandon Roads as part of the Glen Lennox Development. As part of the development agreement, the developer of Glen Lennox will re-align this portion of Flemington Road. The only abutting property owner of this closure is the developer of Glen Lennox. The road will continue to maintain a 50 foot right-of-way width through the re-alignment and will be closed to the public during construction.
