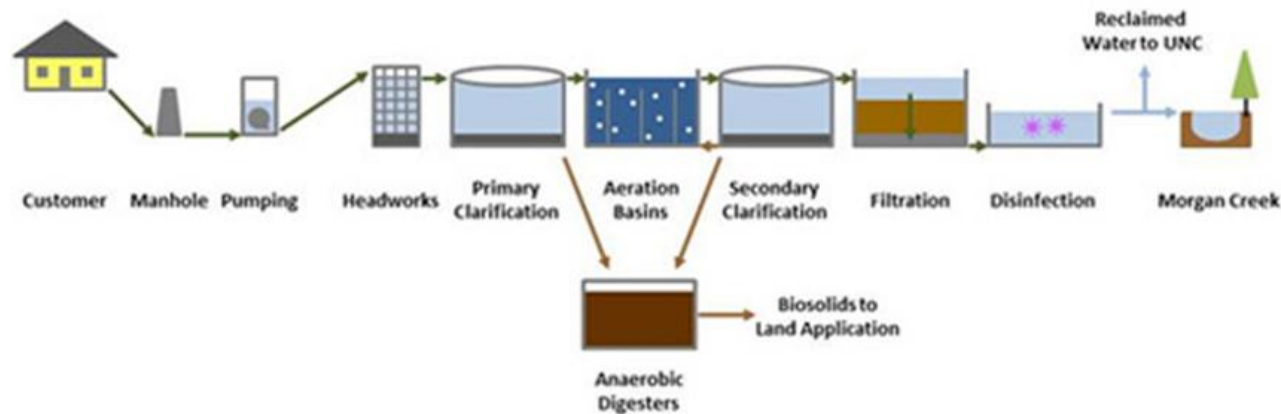

Tour of OWASA's Wastewater (Sewage) Treatment Plant

Orange Water and Sewer Authority (OWASA)
4170 Old Mason Farm Road, Chapel Hill, NC



Learn how wastewater becomes a reusable resource. The Mason Farm Wastewater Treatment Plant uses physical, chemical and biological processes to treat wastewater to a very high level before releasing it to Morgan Creek or for use as reclaimed water for non-drinking purposes. Participants are required to wear closed toe, walking shoes (no heels). Mostly outside. Limit 15 people per tour. Meet at the wastewater treatment plant entrance.
