CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT will operate on a Saturday schedule (no U or NU routes).



Waiting for the bus is getting better

Chapel Hill Transit has recently revamped five bus shelters including this one in Meadowmont. They're testing solar powered lighting at bus stops and bus shelters. Another priority effort, says Chapel Hill Transit Director Brian Litchfield, is ensuring that bus stops are friendly for people with disabilities (ADA compliance). They're starting with nine heavily used stops in the system to assess how best to bring them into ADA compliance. It's all part of our ongoing commitment to improving customer service and access.
