Chapel Hill launches mobile app to connect with residents

The Town of Chapel Hill has launched Chapel Hill Connect – a free mobile app that allows residents to easily report non-emergency issues located within Chapel Hill town limits to Town staff. The app allows users to submit a description, picture and location of an issue, such as a pothole, sidewalk concern or blocked storm drain.

Additional features of the app allow residents easy access to the latest town news and events, Chapel Hill Transit schedules, parking information, swimming pool schedules and more.
