Winter Holiday Service Schedule

Most municipal offices will be closed Dec. 24–26.

RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION: No trash collection Monday or Tuesday (Dec. 24–25). Monday routes will be collected Thursday, Dec. 27. Tuesday routes will be collected Friday, Dec. 28. No yard waste collection this week.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING will not be collected Tuesday, Dec. 25. Tuesday routes will be collected Saturday, Dec. 29.

COMMERCIAL REFUSE COLLECTION: No trash collection Monday and Tuesday (Dec. 24–25). These routes will be collected by the end of the week.

ORANGE COUNTY LANDFILL will be closed Dec. 24–25.

WASTE AND RECYCLING CENTERS will be closed Dec. 25–26. Eubanks Road and Walnut Grove Church Road locations will be open 7 a.m.–noon Monday, Dec. 24; other locations will be closed Dec. 24.

CHAPEL HILL PUBLIC LIBRARY will be closed Dec. 24–26.

CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT will not operate on Dec. 25. On Dec. 24 and Dec. 26, Transit will operate on Saturday schedules (Saturday CM, CW, D, FG, JN, T and V routes); U and NU routes will not operate, and EZ Rider will provide service from 8:15 a.m. to 6:52 p.m. The 420 route will not operate Dec. 24. On Dec. 26 and 27, NU, A-Limited and Safe Rides will not operate.

HOUSING: Office and Maintenance Division will be closed. For emergency maintenance services, call 919-968-2855.

Tree Collection

Town crews will pick up holiday trees and wreaths for mulching on the regular yard waste collection schedule. Yard waste is collected on Thursday from single-family residences on a Monday trash collection schedule and on Fridays from those with Tuesday trash collection.

Remove all decorations, tinsel and wire before leaving trees and wreaths at the curbside along with other yard waste. Residents of apartment complexes should place trees in the area designated by property managers.
