This two-day event provides community members with an inside look at how the Police Department functions. **RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION:** No trash collection Tuesday, Jan. 1. Tuesday routes will be collected Wednesday, Jan. 2. No change to yard waste collection. Holiday trees and wreaths will be collected on the regular yard waste collection schedule.

**CURBSIDE RECYCLING:** No recycling collection Tuesday, Jan. 1. Make-up day Saturday, Jan. 5.

**COMMERCIAL REFUSE COLLECTION:** No trash collection Tuesday, Jan. 1. Tuesday's trash will be collected later in the week.

**ORANGE COUNTY LANDFILL and WASTE AND RECYCLING CENTERS** will be closed.

**CHAPEL HILL PUBLIC LIBRARY** will be closed.

**CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT** will not operate on Sunday, Dec. 30 and Tuesday, Jan. 1. On Saturday, Dec. 29, Transit will operate on a Saturday schedule; Tar Heel Express shuttles will begin at 10:30 a.m. On Monday, Dec. 31, Transit will operate on a Saturday

schedule (CM, CW, D, FG, JN, T and V routes); U and NU routes will not operate and GoTriangle 420 will operate. EZ Rider will provide service from 8:15 a.m. to 6:52 p.m. On Wednesday, Jan. 2, NU and A-Limited routes will not operate. Tar Heel Express shuttles will begin at 5:30 p.m.
