## Aquatic Center Closed Feb. 11–19

Homestead Aquatic Center will be closed Feb. 11–19 for maintenance. During the closure, the Community Center pool will operate on a revised schedule in order to accommodate as many activities as possible. In addition to the Community Center pool, pass holders will be able to show their CHPR pass/fob to swim at the following pools:

- Chapel Hill-Carrboro YMCA at 980 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. (pass holders swim free per facility schedule)
- Bowman Gray Pool on campus at UNC, 300 South Rd., (pass holders swim free per facility schedule)
- Hollow Rock Racquet & Swim Club, 5100 Erwin Road, Durham, (M–F 10 a.m.–12 p.m., 1–4 p.m.; Sat 1–4 p.m.; Sun 10 a.m.–4 p.m.).
- Orange County Sportsplex, 101 Meadowlands Dr., Hillsborough (they ask that our patrons NOT use the pool from 4–7:30 p.m. on weekdays and 9 a.m.–noon on Saturdays.)

The Homestead Aquatic Center Lobby will not be open during the maintenance closure. Those wishing to register for programs or purchase swim passes can do so at the Chapel Hill Community Center, 120 S. Estes Drive.

Our indoor pools provide year round aquatics programs and aqua fitness classes for youth and adults.
