Transit Routes Detours April 13

The Chapel Hill Transit Saturday FG, T and V routes will be detoured on April 13, 2019, due to the annual Tar Heel 10 Miler. Allow extra travel time. Minor delays may occur.

The FG route will be detoured from 8:50 a.m. to 10 a.m. along Fordham Boulevard, right on Manning Drive, right on South Columbia Street, right on South Road and left on Raleigh Street.

Westbound bus stops on Raleigh Road from Greenwood Road to Country Club Road and on South Road from Country Club Road to Raleigh Street will not be served during these times. Customers may board at alternate bus stops at the Glen Lennox Shopping Center and on Raleigh Street.

The Saturday T route will not serve Franklin Street (Varsity) and Hillsborough Street from 8:15 a.m. to 9:13 a.m. and will be detoured along Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. to South Columbia Street.

The Saturday V route will be detoured along Fordham Boulevard and will not serve South Road, South Columbia Street and Franklin Street from 8:45 a.m. to 10:14 a.m.
