

**PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF CHAPEL HILL
CONSENTING TO APPLICATION OF THE EXTENSION
OF THE PROCLAMATION OF ORANGE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA
DATED MAY 21, 2020 WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF CHAPEL HILL
AND FURTHER ADOPTING THE PROCLAMATION OF ORANGE COUNTY
FOR THE PURPOSES OF MAKING IT APPLICABLE
WITHIN THOSE PORTIONS OF CHAPEL HILL IN DURHAM COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Orange County Board of Commissioners Chair Penny Rich has signed, on May 21, 2020, a further Proclamation modifying and extending until June 30, 2020, the previous Orange County Proclamations in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis (incorporating Executive Order 141 signed by North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper on May 20, 2020, with some modifications); and

WHEREAS, said proclamation and the restrictions contained therein may be made applicable within the Town of Chapel Hill's jurisdiction with the consent of the Mayor of Chapel Hill pursuant to N.C.G.S. 166A-19.22(b)(2); and

WHEREAS, in light of the data available related to the impacts of COVID-19 in Orange County and Chapel Hill, the extension of said restrictions previously established are necessary and appropriate as we strive to keep our community safe and reduce the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Town of Chapel Hill does not lie within the boundaries of Orange County.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Pam Hemminger, Mayor of the Town of Chapel Hill, do hereby proclaim the continued existence of a STATE OF EMERGENCY within the Town of Chapel Hill, and, pursuant to the authority granted to me by State law and Town ordinance, hereby ORDER as follows:

1. I consent to the application of said Orange County Extension Proclamation dated May 21, 2020 within the Town of Chapel Hill pursuant to N.C.G.S. Sec. 166A-19.22(b)(2) modifying and extending the previously established restrictions to June 30, 2020.
2. I further adopt and order that this modification and extension of the prior Proclamations and their terms to be applicable within the portions of Chapel Hill in Durham County.
3. Pursuant to the County Order applicable within the Town of Chapel Hill through this Proclamation, the specific additional restrictions beyond those in Executive Order 141 are as follows:
 - a. Prohibited "Mass Gatherings" as defined in EO 141 shall include all indoor meetings of more than 10 people including meetings of public bodies (Pursuant to EO 141 worship services, spiritual gatherings, weddings, and funerals are exempt from this restriction), and
 - b. The mandatory mitigation measures set out in EO 138, Section 7B.2. shall apply to all long-term care facilities described in Section 7A.3., which are situated in Orange County, and
 - c. All restaurant, personal care, grooming, tattoo, and retail employees and staff shall wear a Face Covering while on duty, however, notwithstanding this general requirement, people whose religious beliefs prevent them from wearing a Face Covering, people who cannot wear a Face Covering due to a medical or behavioral condition, and people who are under twelve (12) years of age are excepted from the requirement to wear a Face Covering. Children under two (2) years of age shall not wear a Face Covering so that their breathing may not be inhibited, and


- d. It is recommended that all businesses require customers to wear a Face Covering while inside the business, and
- e. Pursuant to the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services guidelines restaurants shall limit customers at tables so that no more than six (6) people shall be seated together at the same table. However, more than six (6) people may sit together at the same table if they are members of the same household.

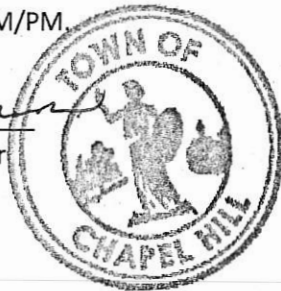
Should EO 141 be modified or terminated prior to June 30, 2020 its terms shall remain in effect in Orange County until this Amendment is modified or amended by the undersigned.

This Proclamation shall be effective May 8, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. (Eastern Daylight Time) and remain in effect until June 30, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. unless rescinded earlier or modified or extended by a further Proclamation.
