

**PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL  
CONSENTING TO THE APPLICATION, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF CHAPEL HILL,  
OF THE DECLARATION OF ORANGE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA DATED JUNE 26, 2020  
AMENDING THE FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS DURING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY AND  
INCORPORATING THE PROVISIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 147  
OF THE GOVERNOR OF NORTH CAROLINA**

**AND FURTHER**

**ADOPTING THE DECLARATION OF ORANGE COUNTY  
FOR THE PURPOSES OF MAKING IT APPLICABLE  
WITHIN THOSE PORTIONS OF CHAPEL HILL IN DURHAM COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Orange County Board of Commissioners Chair Penny Rich has signed, on June 26, 2020, an Amendment to the Declaration of State of Emergency, modifying the previous Orange County Declarations in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis (incorporating Executive Order (EO) 147 signed by North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper on June 24, 2020, with some modifications); and

WHEREAS, said Amendment to the Declaration and the restrictions contained therein may be made applicable within the Town of Chapel Hill's jurisdiction with the consent of the Mayor of Chapel Hill pursuant to N.C.G.S. 166A-19.22(b)(2); and

WHEREAS, in light of the data available related to the impacts of COVID-19 in Orange County and Chapel Hill, the restrictions previously established and the additional requirements for face coverings and the other provisions of EO 147, as modified by the County's June 26, 2020 Amendment to the Declaration of State of Emergency, are necessary and appropriate as we strive to keep our community safe and reduce the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Town of Chapel Hill does not lie within the boundaries of Orange County.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Pam Hemminger, Mayor of the Town of Chapel Hill, do hereby proclaim the continued existence of a STATE OF EMERGENCY within the Town of Chapel Hill, and, pursuant to the authority granted to me by State law and Town ordinance, hereby ORDER as follows:

All of the terms of the Amendment to the Declaration of State of Emergency in Orange County dated June 26, 2020:


are made applicable within the corporate limits of the Town of Chapel Hill in both Orange County by consent; and,

further, are adopted and made applicable within those portions of the Town of Chapel Hill in Durham County.

This Proclamation shall be effective June 26, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. (Eastern Daylight Time) and remain in effect until rescinded or modified or extended by a further Proclamation.
