Street Improvement Project Under Way

The Town of Chapel Hill has begun its annual street resurfacing program. The streets or portions of streets listed below are planned for resurfacing. Manhole and

water valves will be adjusted and raised prior to the paving.

Adelaide Walters Street, Brigham Road, Clover Drive, Community Center Drive, Conner Drive, Culbreth Park Drive, Deepwood Road, Dorsett Pt., Douglas Road, Eastwood Road, Ellen Place, Glenview Place, Halifax Road, Hanft Knoll, Lakeshore Lane, Landerwood Lane, Marin Drive, Marin Place, Overland Drive, Perkins Drive, River Birch Lane, Sunset Street, Tinkerbell Road (S) and Treetop Place.
