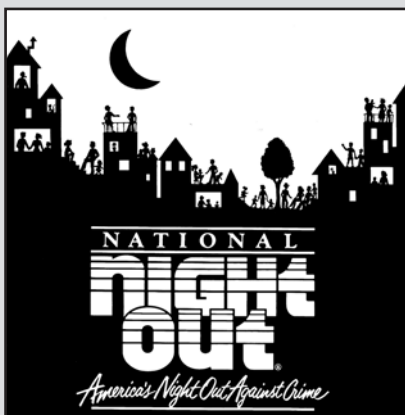

Lease Extension Agreement: Hargraves Community Center

The Council will consider a proposal to execute a two-year lease extension agreement with Holmes Child Care, Inc. for approximately 3,850 square feet of space in the basement of the Hargraves Recreation Center, 216 N. Roberson St. The current lease would be extended for two years from Jan. 1, 2011, until Dec. 31, 2012. The lease amount would be \$250 per month. The lease would allow Holmes Child Care, Inc. to operate a day care center under North Carolina Day Care rules.
