## Thanksgiving Holiday Service Schedule

Most municipal offices will be closed Nov. 25 and 26 in observance of Thanksgiving.

**RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION:** There will be no residential collection Thursday or Friday.

**COMMERCIAL REFUSE COLLECTION:** There will be no commercial collection Thursday.

**CURBSIDE RECYCLING:** There will be no curbside collection on Thursday, Nov. 25. Thursday routes will be collected Saturday, Nov. 27. There will be no change in schedule on Friday.

**ORANGE COUNTY LANDFILL** will be closed Thursday, Nov. 25, and will re-open at 7 a.m. Friday, Nov. 26.

**ORANGE COUNTY SOLID WASTE CONVENIENCE CENTERS** will be closed Thursday and will re-open at 7 a.m. Friday.

**CHAPEL HILL TRANSIT** will not operate on Thursday, Nov. 25. A Saturday Service schedule will be in effect on Friday and Saturday, U and NU routes will not operate. On Sunday, a Reduced Sunday Service schedule will be in effect: U route will begin operating at 1:50 p.m., NU routes will begin operating at 1:45 p.m. Safe Rides will not operate and will resume on Thursday, Dec. 2.

**HOUSING:** Office and Maintenance Division will be closed. For emergency maintenance services, call (919) 968-2855.

**PUBLIC LIBRARY:** The library will be closed Thursday and Friday.

**PARKING SERVICES:** The parking office will be closed Thursday and Friday. On-street parking meters and Town-owned lots and the Wallace Deck will be free on Thursday. The Wallace deck and Lot 2 will operate from 9:30 a.m. to 12:15 a.m. Friday and Saturday, and regular enforcement of all parking will resume on Saturday.
